The Board of Directors together with Rimrock management continue to monitor the restrictions set in place by authorities related to Covid-19 for businesses. We also continue to place members' and employees' health and safety first.

Douglas County remains in Phase 1 of the Washington State Phased Approach to reopening business. When Douglas County moves to Phase 2 Rimrock will open and follow the recommendations of the Phased Approach in order to limit the possibilities for the exposure of both staff and members.

Today Rimrock's shared facilities remain closed with the exception of the restroom at the tent camping area. The restroom in the tent camping area will be open for use as of 6/2/2020.

The Rimrock Board of Directors and Management are currently deliberating the opening of the shared facilities. We are actively preparing for what comes next and the stages that will follow also.

The Board of Directors and Rimrock management have been closely monitoring the restrictions set in place by our local and federal authorities related to Covid-19 for businesses. We would like to emphasize that we are continuing to place members' and employees' health and safety first as we continue to evaluate the temporary closure of Rimrock.

Rimrock's facilities, which include but are not limited to the campground, clubhouse, showers, pool, kitchen, and other common areas, will remain closed for the remainder of May 2020. In addition, Rimrock Membership should anticipate continued operational disruptions for the remainder of Phase 1 of Washington's Phased Approach for reopening businesses.

The Board of Directors will work on clarifying what opportunities will be brought by Phase 2, as determined by Douglas County & State and local Health Districts, and what that will mean for beginning to open up Rimrock Meadows for recreational use by its members. The shared recreational facilities will likely open gradually. A plan for the opening of the first portions of the shared facilities is being crafted and will be shared by June 1.

We all look forward to when we can enjoy the fullness of recreational activities at Rimrock again. At this time members are free to use their personal properties in line with the Bylaws and CC&Rs. Many members have been taking advantage of this opportunity to spend recreational time on their private property.

We would like to thank you in advance for your cooperation and support as we move through this phased approach. The sacrifices all of us are making today are emblematic and potentially lifesaving. Please help us help each other by adhering to the guidelines set forth by our community.
